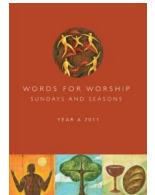
New Resources for Worship and Sacramental Life

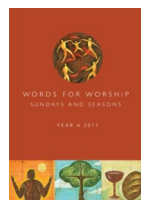
